Oyster Shell



Oyster Shell is an all natural and high quality source of the essential plant nutrient calcium. Ancient oyster shells are carefully harvested and then ground into small, medium and coarse particles. These irregular shapes provide a sustained release of this valuable nutrient and help prevent deficiencies that can diminish plant development. Oyster Shell also aids in improving structure of soils and building optimum tilth.

APPLICATION RATES

2 cups \approx 1 lb; 1/2 cup \approx 4 oz; 1 tbsp \approx 0.5 oz

Vegetable Gardens & Flower Beds: To prepare new gardens, apply 3-6 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mix into the top 3" of garden soil in spring or fall. For new transplants, add 1-2 tsp per hole, mix into soil and water in well.

Lawns: In fall or spring, spread 10-50 lbs per 1,000 square feet depending on soil analysis and water in well. Repeat annually, with rates determined by soil testing.

Outdoor Containers: For new plantings, add 1-2 tbsp per gallon of soil and mix thoroughly OR add 0.5-1 lb per cubic yard. For established plants, lightly mix 1-2 tbsp per gallon into the soil surface every other month during the growing season.

Trees & Shrubs: Spread 1 lb per 1" of trunk diameter around the base outwards to the drip line, mix into soil surface and water in well. For new trees, prepare transplant hole and mix 1-2 cups with the backfill soil. Use the amended soil to fill in around the new tree and water in well.

Row Crops/Acreage: Apply 500-2,000 lbs per acre initially followed by annual maintenance applications depending on soil analysis and crop requirements.
