Feather Meal is derived from hydrolyzed, dried and ground poultry feathers and is an all natural source of slow release nitrogen. It is perfect for heavy feeders and long season crops such as corn, tomatoes and fall harvested vegetables. Feather Meal should be incorporated into soils before planting, or side dressed throughout the growing season to provide a steady release of nitrogen, necessary to optimize plant growth. Nitrogen is essential for all types of growing plants, and an adequate seasonal supply ensures plenty of shoots, flowers, fruits and vegetables.

APPLICATION RATES

2.5 cups = 1 lb; 'c. cup = 3.2 cut | Tap = 0.4 oz Vegetable Gardens & Flower Beds: To prepare new pardens, appl; 3-6 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mit pardens, appl; 3-6 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mit hole, mix into soil and water in well. To feed established plants, side dress 2-4 c. depending on plant size and desire growth rate, once each month during the growing season. Soil and mix thoroughly off and 5-10 lbs per cubic yard. For established plants, lightly mix 1.3 Tbsp per galon into the soil and mix thoroughly off and 5-10 lbs per cubic yard.
