DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Breaking coir bale into smaller pieces will increase the speed of saturation and ease of use. Submerge material in enough water to cover, and allow to soak for 30 minutes. Stir and mash to assure that all dry material is separated and saturated. Add more water if necessary. One compressed bale will yield approximately 30 gallons of ready-to-use coir fiber.
