APPLICATION RATES

Approximate Conversions 1 1/2 cups ≈ 1 lb 1/2 cup ≈ 5 oz 1 Tbsp ≈ 0.6 oz



Vegetable Gardens & Flower Beds:

To prepare new gardens, apply 2.5-5 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mix into the top 3" of soil.
For new transplants, add 1-2 Tbsp per hole, mix into soil and water in well.
To feed established plants, side dress 1-2 oz once each month during the growing season to promote fruiting and flowering.



Liquid Preparations:

Add 1-2 Tbsp per gallon of water and let steep up to 48 hours agitating periodically. Apply the solution directly to the soil around plants or filter and apply as a foliar spray. Be sure to use all of the solution once it is prepared.



Containers:

For new plantings, add 1-2 Tbsp per gallon of soil and mix thoroughly **OR** add 2.5-5 lbs per cubic yard.
For established plants, lightly mix 1 Tbsp per gallon into the soil surface once each month during the growing season.

1. Dig



2. Feed

Follow the application rates on the back of the box

Remove plant from container and gently loosen roots



3. Plant

Fill remaining gaps with soil and press gently to remove air gaps



4. Water

Saturate the soil well just after transplanting

Aim to keep the soil damp, not wet, while the plant becomes established
