APPLICATION RATES

Approximate Conversions: 8 cups ≈ 1 lb 1 cup ≈ 2 oz 1 Tbsp ≈ 0.1 oz



Vegetable Gardens & Flower Beds:

To prepare new gardens, apply 1-2 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mix into the top 3" of garden soil.

For new transplants, add 1 tsp per hole, mix into soil and water in well.

To feed established plants, side dress 1-2 tsp, depending on size of plant and desired growth rate, once each month during the growing season.



Containers:

For new plantings, add 1-2 tsp per gallon of soil and mix thoroughly **OR** add 2.5-5 lbs per cubic yard.

To feed established plants, lightly mix 1 tsp per gallon of soil into the soil surface once each month during the growing season.



Liquid Preparations:

Add 1-2 Tbsp per gallon of water and let steep up to 48 hours, agitating periodically. Apply the solution directly to the soil around plants or apply as a foliar spray. Be sure to use all of the solution once it is prepared.
