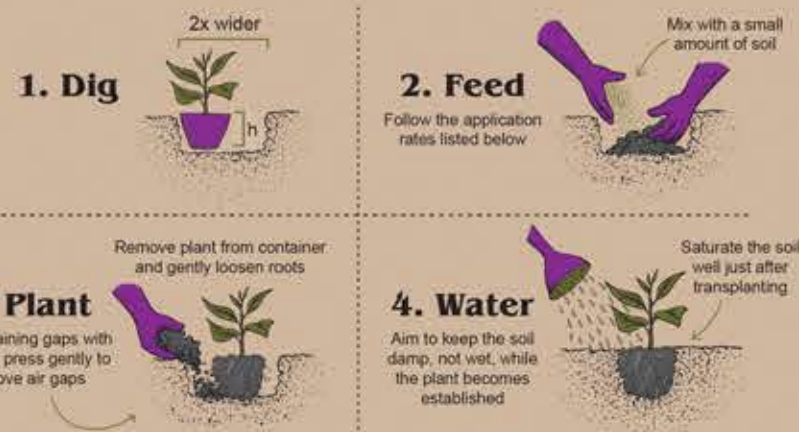


Transplanting Basics

APPLICATION RATES



Vegetable Gardens & Flower Beds:
To prepare new gardens, apply 2-4 lbs per 100 square feet and thoroughly mix into the top 3" of soil.
For new transplants, add 1-2 Tbsp per hole, mix into soil and water in well.
To feed established plants, side dress 2-4 oz per plant, depending on plant size and desired growth rate, once each month during the growing season.

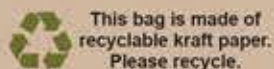


Containers:
For new plantings, add 1-2 Tbsp per gallon of soil and mix thoroughly.
OR add 4-10 lbs per cubic yard.
For established plants, mix 1-2 Tbsp per gallon of soil into the soil surface once each month during the growing season.



Trees & Shrubs:
Spread 1 lb per 1" of trunk diameter around the base outwards to the drip line, mix into soil surface and water in well.
For new trees, prepare transplant hole and mix 1-2 cups with the backfill soil. Use amended soil to fill in around the new tree and water in well.

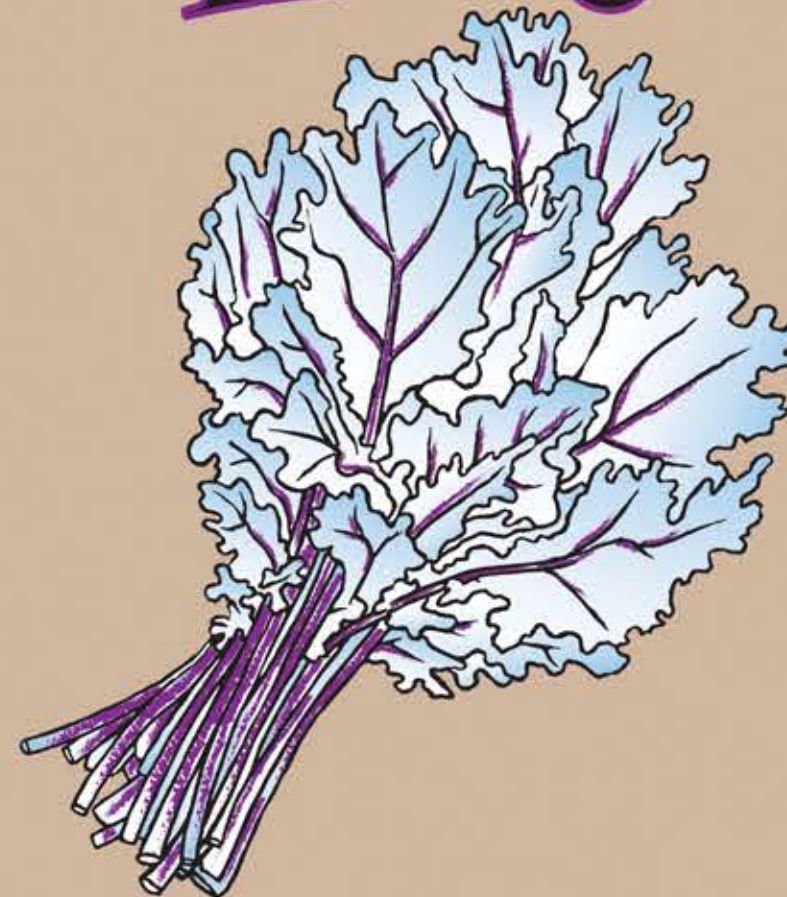

Feather Meal is derived from hydrolyzed, dried and ground poultry feathers and is an all natural source of slow release nitrogen. It is perfect for heavy feeders and long season crops such as corn, tomatoes and fall harvested vegetables. Feather Meal should be incorporated into soils before planting, or side dressed throughout the growing season to provide a steady release of nitrogen. Nitrogen is essential for all types of growing plants, and an adequate seasonal supply ensures plenty of shoots, flowers, fruits and vegetables.



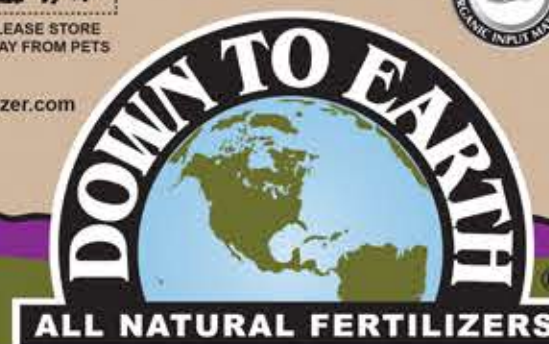
